DRAYTON MANOR HIGH SCHOOL TIME CAPSULE

Students and staff were invited to suggest items for the time capsule, which should be opened as part of the school's centenary celebrations in October 2030. The time capsule is buried outside the Frances Moore building underneath the canopy below the right hand window. There is a plaque to mark the spot.
